Parables	How Do Christians Use the Bible?
<p>When Jesus wanted to teach a particular lesson to a crowd of people, he would often tell them <b>parables</b>.</p> <p>Jesus told <b>parables</b> so people could remember and understand what he had taught them.</p>	<p><b>Christians</b> read the <b>Bible</b> because it contains rules and advice from God. They may talk to other <b>Christians</b> about what it means to them.</p> <p>Some <b>Christians</b> study the <b>Bible</b>. This means that they read and think about it in detail, to gain a better understanding of God.</p>

### Glossary

Key Vocabulary	
<b>psalms</b>	Poems and songs recorded in the <b>Bible</b> .
<b>parables</b>	A story told by Jesus, to teach a particular lesson.
<b>proverbs</b>	Wise sayings recorded in the <b>Bible</b> .
<b>Gospels</b>	Four books in the New Testament that tell us about Jesus' life, from his birth up to his death and resurrection.
<b>prophecy</b>	A message given by God, that is delivered to his people by a specially chosen person (a prophet).
