Our KC Knowledge Organisers have been designed to support with memory skills in order to retain key facts. At the start of each **Big Question**, there will be an organiser for the majority of subjects. These are found on the school website at the start of the term and referred to regularly throughout the term in school within lessons. Using these at home can provide further opportunities for **challenge activities** for our pupils and **engage parents and carers** in our pupils' learning. Why not challenge your child further? Investigate and research the topic independently, play games to learn the **new facts** and remind your child what all the **vocabulary** means and how to spell them. Here are some ideas for some games and activities to support your child's learning:

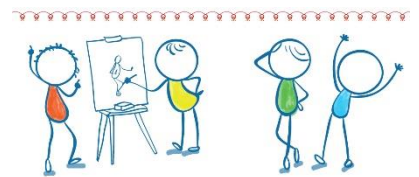


Play charades!

Using the vocabulary or facts, act out the meaning for each other, taking turns.

Have a go at Pictionary!

Each person draws out the meaning of a



word or draws a fact or event. Can you guess what's being drawn?

Play Snap!

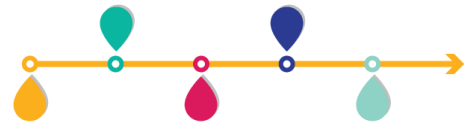
You could write a piece of vocabulary on one card and the meaning on another

Create a timeline!

Map out the events in this learning and show them on a timeline.

Use atlases, online maps or a globe to find the location of places within this Big Question.

Create a quiz!

Use your knowledge organiser to create a quiz for members of the family.

Who can get the most correct answers?



What's the missing word?

Try writing sentences with some of our key vocabulary or facts missing. Can you use the Knowledge

Organiser to help you find the missing word or fact?
